**8. Minimum Entries**

The minimum number of entries per class shall be **8**. If insufficient entries are received for a class, classes may be cancelled or combined at the discretion of the Organiser.

**9. Format of Racing**

Clubman Pro

There will be two timed qualifying sessions for the “Pro Clubman” class.

First timed qualifying with carby session; 2 laps Carby session & then 4 minutes Qualifying.

Second qualifying session 4 minutes.

Top 10 shootout for Clubman Pro to determine poll position & starting positions.

3\* 10 lap heats,

Third heat in Clubman Pro – the top 15 are reverse grid ie 15<sup>th</sup> starts 1<sup>st</sup>, 14<sup>th</sup> starts 2<sup>nd</sup> and so on.

Prefinal 12 laps

20 lap Final.

All other Classes

There will be one timed qualifying session. Timed qualifying with carby session; 2 laps Carby session & then 4 minutes Qualifying.

3\* 10 lap heats,

Prefinal 12 laps

18 lap Final.

## OVER SUBSCRIBED CLASSES - MORE THAN 40 KARTS

After qualifying the first 35 proceed to the heats, the remaining qualifiers are required to do a REPECHARGE race over 10 laps. Grid Fastest time in grid one and so on. The first five will proceed.

For **Pro Clubman**, if there is enough entries (at the discretion of NSKC), the remainder of competitors, they will be placed in a **Group B** and have 2\* 10 lap heats, Prefinal of 12 laps & Final of 15 laps. There will be **No TROPHIES** for **Group B**.

The removal of both hands from the steering wheel or both feet from the pedals will result in the driver being penalised.

Camping is not permitted. Animals are not allowed, excluding guide dogs for the vision impaired.
